Responsibilities

The Community Beautification Supervisor is responsible for the coordination of groundskeeping and beautification of the common areas of Saik'uz First Nation. The Supervisor's duties include tasks such as:

- Maintaining equipment and tools
- Training all workers in the proper and safe operation of all tools and equipment, such as lawn mowers, tree pruners, and clippers
- Ensuring all workers are correctly and consistently using appropriate PPE such as safety glasses, gloves, and proper footwear
- Scheduling workers and designating areas of work
- Providing regular progress reports and updates to upper management

This is a summer position and ends in the fall.
