- Assist with classroom set up and clean up
- Maintain confidentiality in all matters relating to Saik'uz First Nation
- Observe the children in the Daycare's care and complete all necessary documentation
- Operate in a team setting with a focus on collaborative effort and mutual respect
- Support, advocate for, and empower children and families
